The Wabi-Sabi philosophy guiding the GUJI collections aims to create a Zen-like atmosphere, aligned with seven key design principles

Kanso (簡素) Simplicity
Fukinsei (不均整) Asymmetry or Irregularity
Shizen (自然) Natural
Shibumi (渋味) Simple beauty
Yugen (幽玄) subtle grace
Datsuzoku (脱俗) escaping from habits
Seijaku (静寂) tranquillity, stillness or solitude

The GUJI collections are named by the principles: **Engineered oak floors**: Shibumi, Shibumi-Oki and

Wabi-Sabi.

Hybrid floors: Yugen and Seijaku.

Laminate floors: Kanso.

Care & Maintenance Summary









GUJI Timber Flooring stays beautiful with proper care.

1. Routine Maintenance:

- Vacuum, mop, or sweep weekly. Use a damp cloth mop with pHneutral cleaner; avoid excess water or harsh chemicals.
- o Do not use steam mops, steel wool, or wax.
- Use a vacuum with a brush head and clean spills promptly with a dry cloth. For stubborn stains, use a damp cloth with a pH-neutral cleaner.
- Use drip pans under plants, maintain indoor temperatures between 17°C-23°C, and avoid heating systems with floating installations.

2. Preventative Maintenance:

- Use mats at entrances and under heavy items. Trim pet nails and use floor protectors. Avoid walking on the floor with high heels or shoes in need of repair. Keep sharp objects and hot materials away.
- Block direct sunlight with curtains or UV film. Avoid rubber-backed rugs and non-breathable mats. Clean spills promptly and avoid foods and drinks that may stain.
- Do not use steam mops or excess water. Maintain indoor humidity between 45%-60% and protect the floor from extreme temperature changes.

3. Fix Dings and Scratches:


 Repair minor scratches with a matching color staining pen. Use putty and stains for deeper scratches. Test repair kits on a less visible area first. For severe damage, replace the planks.

Common Characteristics of Timber Floors

GUJI Timber Flooring is crafted from natural materials, resulting in variations in color, texture, and inherent features between individual pieces and batches. Samples and reproductions in print or photography serve as a general guide for color, but may not fully represent the overall appearance or design of the flooring.
